Welcome to canoe slalom races in Falun, Sweden. We will make our best to give you a pleasant visit and good racing in Scandinavia's first whitewater park. We hope the race format will give you value for the trip.

We welcome all ages and ambitions and will offer you good slalom.

The Venue

Falun Slalom Cup will take place at Falun Whitewater Park which will be inaugurated in June 2018.

The course has a length of 130 m and a drop of 2.5 m.

The flow will be 4 m³/s - white water level II-III.

Race format

- One semifinal run
- A-final: max 10 paddlers but 2 less than semifinal
- B-final: all other paddlers

Point system and rules

The three best of four races counts for the overall results.

Points = place. First place gets 1 point. Second place gets 2 points etc.

Rules are modified ICF slalom rules. We might allow 8 upstream gates.

Race dinner at Främby Udde

The picture shows Främby udde where we welcome all participants, coaches, friends and parents for dinner on Saturday evening. It is near the competition place and costs 10 € per person.

Classes

K1 Women, C1 Women, K1 Men, C1 Men
C2 Women, C2 Men, C2 Mixed
No age categories. In the results, age will be noted.

Prize money - totally 6000 €

Top three in each class get prize money for each race, as well as for best overall results.

Participation fees

Entries: 25 € per boat and per race day. Accepted entries = paid start fees. Latest 4 days before start, change to another name in the same club is accepted. Start fees will not be refunded but can be kept for the same club for other Slalomcup races 2018 or for next year.

Deposit: We will take a deposit for the bibs of 50 € from each club. It has to be done **in cash** at the team leaders meeting.

Team leaders meeting

Official team leaders meeting will be held in the Competition Office in the whitewater park on Friday 18:30-19:00. For those not attending the Official Team Leaders meeting: information will be in written form and posted on a board in the park.

Boat storage

There will be specific place for boats in the park. Note that storage is on the owner's risk

Accreditation

All participating clubs gets free entrance in the whitewater park for their staff.

White water training in the park and around

We offer free training in groups in the park for all competitors on Friday 24 August and 12 October from 8:00 until 16:00. The duration of sessions and number of paddlers in groups will depend on the total number of participants for the competitions.

If you want to train in the park before the competitions, book in advance by mail to info@falukanotklubb.se. Training during the week before the competition costs 6 €/paddler/session for registered competitors.

Falu Kanotklubb has a slalom course with 60 gates only 15 minutes' drive from Falun (4 € /person/session). One hour' drive from Falun, you find the river Västerdalälven with a slalom course in Lissfors and very nice natural rapids suitable for slalom and freestyle.

First aid

During the event period 24-26 August and 12-14 October, we will provide basic first aid service. Security of paddlers in the park and on the water is under control of team leaders from participating clubs. All participants are responsible to arrange their costs for their own medical insurance policy.

Parking

During the training period: free in the park.
During the competition days: all teams get one free parking ticket at the Team Leaders meeting. There's additional space nearby.

Access to Falun Whitewater Park

Address: Främbyvägen 3 - 791 52 Falun. The park is situated 1,3 km south of Faluns' city center (red circle on the map).

By train

There are direct trains from Stockholm to Falun. The park is less than 2 km from the train station. We pick you up.

By road

From Danmark: Helsingborg/Malmö (E4) - Jönköping - Mjölby (E50) - Örebro - Borlänge - Falun.

From Göteborg: Örebro (E20) - Örebro - Borlänge (E50) - Falun.

From Stockholm: North to Uppsala - Gävle (E4). Falun (E16).
